Sponsorship

The "nuts-and-bolts" of what's included (and not included).

01

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- The design of the website is already taken care. No additional fee. No involvement on your part.
- Your sponsorship includes pictures, links (to your website or a YouTube video you've created, information, etc. that you supply of your business. .

NOT INCLUDED

- Customization of the website. There is no design fee associated with the website since I own, designed, and created the website. If you would like to have additional content, pages, etc. added to the website, we can discuss your options. There will be a separate charge - either as a flat fee or billed hourly.

03

SPONSORSHIP DETAILS

- You agree to pay the monthly sponsorship fee of \$50/month. We require that your credit card be (safely & securely) stored with our payment service (Wave. apps) for automatic billing each month. You will also receive a receipt.
- You have the option to pay annually. Doing so will pay for 12 months with one month free. Please contact us for an invoice for an annual payment. (\$550)
- You will be notified 30 days prior to the end of your contract to let you know that your contract is up for renewal. If you'd like to continue, you don't need to do anything. If you'd like to terminate the contract at that time, you need to let us know in writing. Your business information will be removed and a new business sponsor will take its place.
- If you decide to terminate your contract prior to its annual renewal, you may find a replacement sponsor (another business for example). Otherwise, you will be responsible for the monthly payments through the remainder of the contract. The new business 1-year contract begins when they take over the sponsorship.

Terms and Conditions

It's important that we're on the same page from the beginning. Here are a few things to make sure that we're both covered. Nothing serious - just some basic guidelines.

POINT OF CONTACT

Touch Point Designs will require one point of contact, usually the Executive Director, of a chamber of commerce or a local business owner. Touch Point Designs requires this person to be available to answer questions arising from the project within 24 hrs on workdays (subject to reasonable exceptions), and to have authority to make related decisions.

05

DISPUTE OF RESOLUTION

Negotiation: I want to work this out. In the event of a dispute, the parties agree to work towards a resolution through good faith negotiation.

Mediation/Arbitration: If talking it over doesn't go well, either party may initiate mediation or binding arbitration in a forum mutually agreed to by the parties.

Litigation: If litigation is necessary, this Agreement will be interpreted based on the laws of the State of Montana, regardless of any conflict of law issues that may arise. The parties agree that the dispute will be resolved at a court of competent jurisdiction in the agreed upon state.

Attorney's Fees: The prevailing party, or "winner" as non-lawyers call it, will be able to recover its attorney's fees and other reasonable costs for a dispute resolved by binding arbitration or litigation, paid by the other party.
